Washington DC Mission Trip A Success!

Trinity "missionaries" returned from Washington DC safely last Saturday after a marvelous week of work and sightseeing in our nation's capitol. Their work included the following:

- DC Central Kitchen – 4,500 meals prepared daily
- Food & Friends – 1,400 clients served daily
- Washington Church of the Brethren Soup Kitchen – 75 guests served lunch daily
- So Others Might Eat – 200-300 guests served breakfast and lunch daily

Of course, there were many other volunteers and staff members working together to be able to accomplish these tasks.

Members of the group visited the Holocaust Museum, National Gallery of Art, all four Smithsonian Museums, the National Botanical Gardens, Arlington National Cemetery. A very long walking tour one afternoon and evening included the White House, Washington Monument, WW II Memorial, Lincoln Memorial, Vietnam and Korean War Memorials, and the FDR Memorial. On Thursday evening the group enjoyed one of the farewell performances of "Riverdance" at Wolf Trap Farm Park.

Our sincere thanks to the congregation for your prayers and financial support of this most meaningful mission trip.

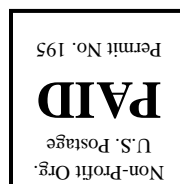
Enrichment Event Being Planned
