Bradley Webster is a rising 7th Grader at Hahira Middle School.

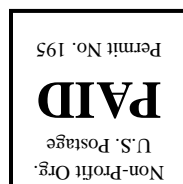

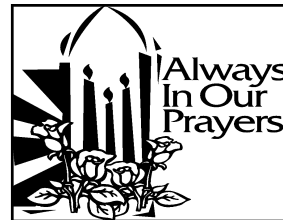
