How Can You Help with High School Mission Trip?

He must become greater, I must become less. John 3:30

Sixteen Trinity high school youth and five adult leaders will depart Sunday, July 4, for a week of service at the Presbyterian Disaster Assistance Camp located in Houma, Louisiana. The camp was established in 2005 in response to several hurricanes that affected the area. While the city is high enough that it was not directly affected by the 6-10 foot storm surge that resulted from Hurricane Rita, many residential areas along the five bayous just south of Houma suffered extensive damage from up to 10 feet of water, some of which stayed for up to three weeks. Youth and leaders will work to repair homes that have still not been restored.

In addition to helping to repair homes affected by Hurricanes, Houma is at the heart of the Gulf Oil crisis as it has been established as the command center for BP's crisis response team. Trinity youth will witness first-hand the devastating effects of this disaster on the residents of these coastal communities.

This week will provide a tremendous opportunity for youth to serve, worship, fellowship and experience a different culture, however we ask for your help:

1. Most importantly, please **pray** for our group for stamina, traveling safety and for all involved to be generous and loving with our service and hearts, even as we labor under physically challenging conditions.
2. Please **pray** for the residents of the communities in which we will serve as they continue to recover from the hurricanes and other challenges.
3. **Help us financially.** We have a few youth coming on the trip who are unable to cover the total registration (\$125 per person). Donations of any amount to help cover their expenses would be greatly appreciated. Their participation will not be affected by their inability to pay, but our registration amount does not actually cover the total expenses, so any donations for any amount would be most helpful. If you would like to donate, you may write a check payable to Trinity Presbyterian, indicate that it is for youth mission trip, and drop in the offering plate or send to the church office.

Thank you for your support of our youth for this important mission activity.


Thank You, Bereavement Committee

Confirmation Sunday

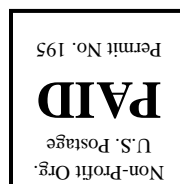

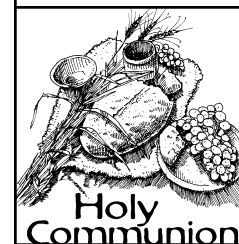

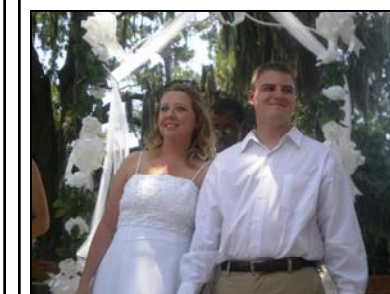
