**A New Twist on Outreach:**

***Super Saturdays at Trinity...SST!***

A few years ago the Session gave approval to what we called at the time "Outdoor Visible Ministry" for Trinity. The idea is to hold regularly scheduled activities on our grounds for church members but especially for any neighbors or passers-by who might want to stop in to have some fun and food with us. Hopefully, if we do it regularly enough, the visibility will show people we are an active church without them having to come inside initially. It may lead to contacts with people who are looking for a church to attend. At least we will share hospitality, food, and a good time with any who come.



We will call it ***Super Saturdays at Trinity*** – SST! for short. We will plan different outdoor activities on the same Saturday every month until the end of the year. Activities will be designed to include all ages. We will serve a simple, free meal during each event. Several Trinity families have been asked to assist with one of the events. This way, no one will have to "work" every event, and all may enjoy the activities either as a participant or a worker.

The plan is to serve a simple hotdog meal, with chips, drinks, and dessert – free of charge to all participants (the cost of the meal will be funded by the church.) One family will be in charge of the food each month, and one family will be responsible for setting up the activity.

Activities may include one of the following each month:

- ~ Water Fun Day
- ~ Outdoor Evening Jazz Concert
- ~ T-Ball/Softball Game Day
- ~ Kite Flying & Pony Ride Day
- ~ Movie Night
- ~ Choral Concert

SST! will be held monthly on the third Saturday, August through December. The first one will be on Saturday, August 21, 2010. It will be a Water Fun Day, including sprinklers, slip-n-slide, water balloon toss, water guns, and the like. The time will be 10:30 am until 12:30 pm. Food will be served throughout the time.

Funds from these collections are used to provide food to people in need.

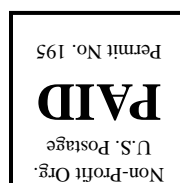
