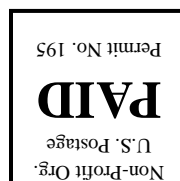
Sunday School Offered for All Ages!

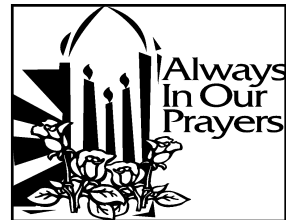
